



## 2026 GUYS & DOLLS BONSPIEL

January 5th, 6th & 7th

1. **Draw Times: Monday and Tuesday:** 9:30 am & 1:00 pm. **Wednesday:** 9:30 am
2. Each game will have eight ends or two hours. Game winners will receive \$20, tied games will be split \$10/\$10.
3. Teams will be awarded 2 points per win and 1 point per tie. The number of ends won and game score should be recorded on a score card & signed by the 3rds of each team. If a team gives up after 6 ends the winning team scores 1 end and 1 point for each unplayed end.
4. Final standings will be determined by total points. A Tie Breaker, if needed, will be the number of ends won and then the total of game scores.
5. Cash Prizes:

1st Place	\$120.00
2nd Place	100.00
3rd Place	80.00
4th Place	60.00
6. There will also be a "Three Ender" award of \$20.00 per draw. The first team to score an exact "Three Ender" hangs the "**Token**" on the scoreboard against the applicable end. Should another team score a "Three Ender" in a later end they claim the "**Token**". The "**Token**" can change hands up until the 6th end. The "**Token**" must be turned in to the Drawmaster at the end of the draw.
7. 50/50 tickets will be sold daily and the draws will be held prior to the afternoon game on Monday & Tuesday and at the end of the luncheon on Wednesday. **Tickets are 3 for \$5.**
8. A buffet lunch will be served on Wednesday at 12:15 pm in the Curling Lounge. The Bar will be open following the afternoon draw on Monday and Tuesday and during lunch on Wednesday.
9. **Wednesday** is an optional dress-up day, the theme this year will be "**A Song or Movie Title**". There will be one cash prize for most original Team, as voted upon by all bonspiel participants.
